



Guided Tour Synopsis

A guided tour by Aquila serves not as a condensed version of the play, but rather as an educational performance meant to guide the student audience through the play's key scenes. An actor hosts the tour by introducing the main characters and providing a narrative link between key scenes. These scenes are acted out in full costume, often with the full set and props used for an actual performance. Guided tours are one hour in length, including a Q&A session. Most are appropriate for grades 4 and up.

Tech: lights and sound are a smaller version of full show unless full show is also played at venue

In addition, a lectern with a microphone on it is required as are two lights from FOH focused to light the lectern and the speaker.
