



## Debate Presentation Workshop

L.A. Theatre Works provides participants with the opportunity to enhance their debate presentation style through acting techniques focusing on diction, projection, timing, body language, purpose and confidence building. The presenting organization will choose a professor/faculty member who will coordinate with students to choose debate topics presented. The presenting organization will ensure that the professor/faculty member will also be present for the entire workshop to help facilitate. The company can work with up to 5 students, each working on 5-7 minutes of a presentation. After each student presents, the actors will then take time for comments and questions.

### **Requirements:**

Number of L.A. Theatre Work's actors: up to 2 (depending on availability)

Number of Participants: 10 minimum/30 maximum (with 5-7 students presenting material)

Age level of Participants: Middle school, High school and College level students

Length of workshop: 60 minutes

Location: Classroom setting

**Technical needs:** The following is to be provided by the presenter:

- Two (2) - three (3) chairs
- One (1) – two (2) tables
- Two (2) – three (3) bottles of water

NOTE: If fewer than 10 participants are present, LATW's workshop leader, at his/her discretion, may alter the content and length of the workshop to suit the size of the group.
